

HOW TO USE PUBLIC TRANSPORT IN VALENCIA



Recommended for Metro & Tram: SUMA CARD



- Metrovalencia is divided into four fare zones: A, B, C, and D.
- The SUMA Card lets you travel seamlessly on Metrovalencia, EMT buses, RENFE Cercanías and MetroBus.
- Free transfers between different modes or lines (within the same zone).
- Lower fares than single tickets, with zone-based pricing.



Alternative Mobility Options


Valenbisi Public Bikes

- 275 stations city-wide
- First 30 minutes free



Taxis & Apps

- Hail on street, at taxi stands, or via phone/app
- Recommended apps: FreeNow, Cabify, Uber

📍 From the faculty

- Best option: Taxi/Uber/Cabify (6-12 euros)
- Take the tram from LA CARRASCA towards MAS DEL ROSARI LINE 4 and get off at PONT DE FUSTA. Then walk for 15 minutes to ADEIT - Fundación Universidad-Empresa

📍 Colegio Mayor Rector Peset

A 4 minutes walk

📍 Residencia Universitaria Resa Damià Bonet

- Best option: Taxi/Uber/Cabify (6-12 euros)
- Take the bus at BLASCO IBÁÑEZ-ACTOR ENRIQUE RAMBAL stop, take bus number 31 towards ESTACIÓN JOAQUIN SOROLLA and get off at PLAZA DE LA REINA

If you're interested in exploring the best of Valencia, these are the must-see spots!

City of Arts and Sciences

Futuristic museums and the incredible Oceanogràfic aquarium.

Ciutat Vella

Wander through Valencia's historic old town—charming plazas, narrow streets, and centuries of culture.

Museum of Fine Arts

Home to works by Goya, El Greco, and Sorolla.

Turia Gardens

A beautiful 9-km park perfect for walking or cycling.

Malvarrosa Beach

Golden sands and fresh seafood, just minutes from the city center.

VALÈNCIA TOURIST CARD

Tourist Card

A card that offers free public transport and free entry to museums and municipal monuments.

Prices

Approximately €15 to €20, depending on the duration.

Where to buy it?

Available at tourist offices: Airport, Plaza del Ayuntamiento, and Joaquín Sorolla Station.

Card Benefits

- Free entry to municipal museums and monuments (e.g. La Lonja, Torres de Serranos/Quart, Museo Fallero, La Almoína...)
- Unlimited travel on EMT buses, Metrobus, Metrovalencia (Zones A, B + Airport), tram, and RENFE Cercanías (Zone AB)
